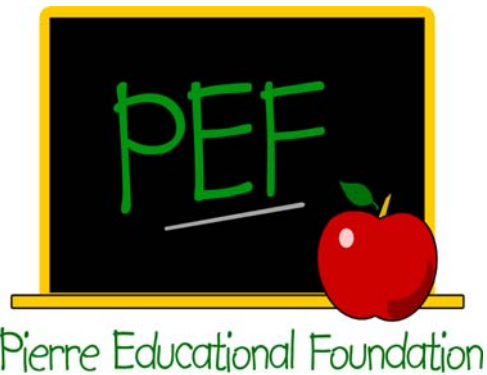

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### Drug Awareness Grants

The Pierre Elks Lodge is donating \$400 to be used for mini grant(s) that meet the goal of educating students on the dangers of drug, alcohol and/or tobacco abuse. Applications for the mini grant may not exceed \$400.

### Criteria for Consideration

Activities intended to educate children about the dangers of substance abuse will be considered. Preference will be given to projects that have sustainable activities. **Note: In the past the PEF has generally not funded projects that, purchase consumable items as one time uses, fund field trips, salaries, or clothing.**

### Note to applicants whose projects are funded

- ✓ All applicants must submit a short article about the success of the program (include pictures if possible) to the Pierre Elks Lodge and the Pierre School District Educational Foundation to include on our website, [www.pierreeducationalfoundation.org](http://www.pierreeducationalfoundation.org) in issues of the *Governor News* newsletter and local media.
- ✓ Items should be purchased by applicant, and the receipt(s) should be submitted to the Pierre School District Educational Foundation. The Foundation will reimburse the purchaser. Any technology purchases must be coordinated through the district's technology coordinator.
- ✓ All receipts and reimbursement must be submitted within one year of the mini-grant being awarded, or the grant becomes null and void.
